Solid Waste Disposal Procedures:

We accept waste from residents and businesses of Macon County – no other areas. To comply with state regulations for disposal at landfills, we must ask that you sort your waste in the following manner:

- **Please bag all household trash** that is not recycled, including empty bottles and jugs of all types. **All bagged trash must be separated from other waste** and disposed in the Compactor Area. (Signs are posted for Bagged Trash)
- **Please sort** Electronics, Appliances, Metal, and Tires from Construction/Building Materials, Furniture Items, and Large rigid plastic items. (Where Signs are posted for Non-Bagged Trash)
- **Please tell the Attendant** if you have Paint, Antifreeze, Lead Acid Batteries, Rechargeable Batteries, or Propane Tanks. These need to be handled in a more sensitive manner.
- If you have other waste not described here, please ask the Attendant about proper disposal **BEFORE** you unload.

NOTE: Liquid Paint CAN NOT be disposed in the regular trash. Water-based paints can be dried and put into the regular trash by using kitty litter, sawdust, or shredded paper to speed the drying process.

The Transfer Station DOES NOT accept

- brush
- leaves or other yard waste
- auto fluids (except antifreeze)
- gas tanks
- explosives
- medical waste
- hazardous waste
- dead animals
